# Estate Range 2017 Riesling

## Tasting Notes

Fragrant nose of kaffir lime, peach blossom and lime zest. A lively palate of peach blossom and lime juice, great length and subtle acidity.

## Winemaking and Viticulture

Riesling is an aromatic grape variety displaying flowery, almost perfumed aromas as well as high acidity. This classic dry Riesling shows all these attributes. Much of the unique character of this wine is developed in the vineyard, low yielding spur-pruned vines with fruit harvested in the cool of the night to ensure fruit is delivered at temperatures less than 20 degrees. The fruit is then lightly pressed and drained and only the free run juice is used to produce this elegant wine. All the fruit is sourced solely from Shaw Vineyard Estate's Murrumbateman vineyard, an area renowned for production of premium cool climate wines. Stelvin closures are used for freshness and to ensure long term quality.
